Roston Chase replaces Kraigg Brathwaite as new West Indies Test captain



New Delhi. Roston Chase has been named the new captain of the West Indies men's Test team, marking a surprising yet significant shift in leadership. The 33-year-old allrounder, who last featured in a Test match over two years ago, will take over the reins from Kraigg Brathwaite, who stepped down from the role in March after a three-year tenure.

Chase's first assignment as captain will come against Australia in a three-match home series slated for June and July. The opening Test in Bridgetown, Barbados – Chase's home ground – will be a landmark moment, as it also marks his 50th Test appearance since debuting in 2016. Over his Test career, Chase has scored 2265 runs at an average of 26.33, including five centuries. With the ball, he's proven handy too, picking up 85 wickets, including a memorable 8 for 60 against England in 2019 at Kensington Oval.

Cricket West Indies (CWI) selected Chase after a rigorous evaluation process, which included psychometric testing and interviews with a panel comprising head coach Daren Sammy, Director of Cricket Miles Bascombe, and Enoch Lewis, Chairman of the Cricket Strategy and Officiating Committee. The final shortlist included John Campbell, Tevin Imlach, Joshua Da Silva, Justin Greaves, and newly appointed vice-captain Jomel Warrican.

"I fully endorse this appointment. Our new captain has earned the respect of his peers, understands the responsibility that comes with the role, and has shown the leadership qualities we need to take this team forward. I urge fans across the region to rally behind him--we're building something special," Head coach Darren Sammy said."This selection process is one of the most comprehensive and forward-thinking we have undertaken. "I am deeply impressed by the professionalism, objectivity, and strategic thinking that shaped the final decision. It sets a new benchmark for leadership appointments in West Indies cricket," CWI president, Kishore Shallow, said.

RCB vs KKR, IPL 2025

Preview: Predicted XI, team news and Bengaluru pitch conditions



New Delhi. Royal Challengers Bengaluru and Kolkata Knight Riders are once again set to face off in the Indian Premier League, this time in the restart of the 2025 season. In the opening fixture earlier this year, RCB mauled KKR by 7 wickets. It was Virat Kohli's first T20 appearance since retiring from T20Is, and he delivered a riveting display of his enhanced skill set — a performance that has gone on to define RCB's campaign this season.

All eyes will once again be on Kohli, who recently announced his retirement from Test cricket — a decision that stunned fans and experts worldwide. The legendary cricketer, who revitalized Test cricket viewership in India during the mid-2010s, bids farewell to the format that he held so dearly.

Kohli's retirement came under tricky circumstances. After an extended period of patchy form in whites, he gave up his baggy blue just before the high-profile tour of England — a country where he had previously led India to some iconic victories.

Now free of the demands of Test cricket, could Kohli become even more driven to finally win an IPL title with Royal Challengers Bengaluru? This isn't a question of his commitment to the side — which has never been in doubt — but more a consideration of what his sharpened focus could mean for the franchise. Kohli has been a consistent performer for RCB, leading them to the finals three times. Yet, the elusive IPL trophy has always slipped away for one reason or another.The season opener marked Kohli's first outing as a two-format player (ODIs and Tests) after stepping away from T20Is in 2024. Now, as the league restarts in 2025, Kohli enters as a single-format international player, having retired from Tests on May 12.

Could this be the final push that tips the scales in RCB's favour? Will Kohli's renewed focus — combined with the team's strong form — drive the franchise to its first-ever IPL title?

Relief, then fire: Neeraj Chopra's 90m mark breakthrough lights a fresh fuse

After years of near misses, Neeraj Chopra finally broke the elusive 90-metre barrier in the Doha Diamond League on Friday, marking a historic milestone. Yet, with fierce rivals rising, this breakthrough signals just the beginning of a new, fiercer battle ahead.

New Delhi. Neeraj Chopra didn't let out a celebratory roar. There was no fist pump into the warm Doha air, no theatrical flourish as he finally conquered the elusive 90-metre mark. Instead, he simply shook his head and allowed himself a wry smile. Relief, not rapture, coloured his expression. The monkey was off his back at last.

On Friday, Neeraj became just the 25th man in history to breach the coveted 90-metre barrier in men's javelin. It was a milestone years in the making. Ever since he unleashed

a stunning 86.48m throw as a teenager at the U20 World Championships in 2016, he had been earmarked for greatness—and he delivered. Two Olympic medals, including a historic gold, a World Championship title, and the Diamond League trophy—he had won it all. Yet one achievement continued to slip just out of reach for India's golden boy from Panipat.

Wherever he went, the 90-metre question followed. Statistically, he has been the most consistent javelin thrower of the modern era, recording 14 throws between 88 and 90 metres since his Olympic triumph in Tokyo. But a nation wanted more – it wanted magic. It wanted 90.He came agonisingly close. At the Stockholm Diamond League in 2022, he fell just six centimetres short. At the Olympic final in Paris, with only one legal throw, he reached 89.45m. Later that year, in the Lausanne Diamond League Final, he edged even nearer—just four centimetres shy.

"A lot of people kept asking whether I'd ever throw 90 metres—because I hadn't done it despite competing at the top level since 2018," Neeraj told RevSportz, moments after his landmark throw in Doha. "I'd hit 88, 89... but never 90. Finally, not just for me, but for all Indians, the weight has lifted. And I



feel like I can go even further," he said, speaking for a nation he once again made proud.

THE IRONY IN DOHA

Ironically, the Doha Diamond League was perhaps the first competition in recent memory where the 90-metre question wasn't raised in the customary pre-event press conference. From his new coach Jan Zelezny to India-Pakistan sporting tensions, Neeraj fielded a range of questions—but not that one. Yet, come Friday evening, as he stepped out for warm-ups, there was a quiet certainty about him. Calm, composed, and purposeful, Neeraj looked like a man on a mission. He reportedly warmed up by casually flinging the spear beyond 80 metres—an early sign of what was to come.

Clad in his signature sky-blue kit, the now-

iconic headband in place and the support belt snug around his hips, Neeraj lined up for his first attempt. The javelin cut through the night sky and landed at 88.44m – a world-leading mark at the time.He looked pleased. It was only his opening throw, in his first major outing of the season.

THE VISIBLE MINOR TWEAKS

In the build-up to Doha, Neeraj had hinted at feeling sharper and injury-free after many years. He was able to overcome a nagging groin injury in the off-season. He had spoken about good rhythm in warm-ups, and the impact of working with Zelezny—the legendary Czech world-record holder—since February. Though their partnership was still new, Neeraj acknowledged technical tweaks and routine changes they had begun to implement. He spoke candidly about finding his feet with Zelezny after five successful years under former coach Klaus Bartonietz. The decision to shake things up was deliberate and bold.The changes were visible in his very first attempt.

He wasn't getting quite as side-on as before, and after braking and releasing, his posture looked more balanced than he was more balanced than ever before.

Suryakumar Yadav's pens heartfelt tribute to Rohit Sharma on Wankhede stand honour

New Delhi.India's T20I captain Suryakumar Yadav paid a heartfelt tribute to ODI skipper Rohit Sharma after a stand at Mumbai's iconic Wankhede Stadium was named in Rohit's honour on May 16. The Mumbai Cricket Association (MCA) officially unveiled the "Rohit Sharma Stand" at the Divecha Pavilion Level 3, marking a proud moment for the India captain, who was present alongside his family.



Suryakumar, taking to social media, praised Rohit not just for his achievements on the field, but also for the humility and leadership he brought to Indian cricket. "Good things happen to good people," Suryakumar wrote, adding that Wankhede had become "even more iconic" because of the honour bestowed on his teammate and long-time friend.

"Congratulations @ImRo45 on achieving incredible things on the cricket ground, from finisher to opener to our captain. You have been an inspiration and our pride in every role... Very rarely comes a leader who leads from the front, and changes the game for better. You are that leader, who has changed not just the game, but the approach, the attitude, the dressing room atmosphere, the

team and redefined the role of a captain," Suryakumar Yadav wrote on his post.

"Like I have said before, good things happen to good people, and you deserve it all and more. Wankhede just got even more iconic," he added. The ceremony took place amidst a period of reflection in Indian cricket, coming shortly after Rohit announced his retirement from Test cricket — just 11 months after he stepped away from T20Is following India's T20 World Cup 2024 triumph. Despite the timing, the event turned into a celebration of Rohit's monumental contributions, with Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, NCP-SCP chief Sharad Pawar, and other dignitaries in attendance.

Rohit, who has been one of Mumbai's most decorated cricketers, has led India to two major ICC trophies in recent years — the T20 World Cup in 2024 and the Champions Trophy in 2025.

Since making his debut in 2007, he has represented India in 159 T20Is, 273 ODIs, and 67 Tests.During the emotional event, Rohit thanked his family — his parents, wife, and brother — for being his constant support through highs and lows.

Shubman Gill, Shreyas Iyer or Rishabh Pant? Gavaskar picks his next India captain



New Delhi. Legendary batter Sunil Gavaskar believes Shubman Gill, Shreyas Iyer, and Rishabh Pant all possess strong leadership qualities, but he backed Gill as the frontrunner to become India's next Test captain.

Following Rohit Sharma's retirement from Test cricket on May 7, the captaincy role remains vacant. India must appoint a new leader ahead of the Test series against England, which begins on June 20 at Headingley in Leeds.Gavaskar noted that Gill, Iyer, and Pant each have distinct captaincy styles, but felt Gill appears to be the most involved on the field.

"It would take a couple of years (to groom future leaders) to get to the level of our super captains (MS Dhoni, Rohit, Virat). All of them brought a different approach to captaincy," Gavaskar told PTI on Star Sports Press Room."When you see Gill, Iyer and Pant, three main pretenders to Indian captaincy you see an amalgamation of all three (Dhoni, Rohit, Virat). Gill probably is more competitive, when there is a decision, he is asking the umpire right away. He is probably a lot more involved," Gavaskar said."Though Pant is behind the stumps, he is also very involved. Iyer too has been superb. All three have brought a lot of positivity in the way they have been captaining," Gavaskar added.

The 25-year-old Shubman Gill has previously captained India in five T20Is during the tour of Zimbabwe last year. He is currently in his second season as captain of the Gujarat Titans (GT) in the Indian Premier League (IPL). Gill made his international debut in 2019 after being part of India's U19 World Cup-winning squad in 2018, and went on to represent Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) in the IPL before joining GT.

Jannik Sinner sets up blockbuster Carlos Alcaraz final after huge scare in semis

New Delhi. World No.1 Jannik Sinner made his way through to the final of the Italian Open 2025 after beating a resilient Tommy Paul in the semis. On Friday, May 16, Sinner rallied back from a set down to beat his American opponent 1-6, 6-0, 6-3 on Centre Court. With the win, Sinner also set up a blockbuster final against Carlos Alcaraz, who beat Lorenzo Musetti earlier in the day.

Sinner looked in all sorts of trouble in the first set after dropping his serve twice and not getting a single chance to break Paul's serve. But once he went 2-0 up in the second set with his first break of the match, Sinner became unstoppable. He earned four more breaks to finish the match in an hour and 43 minutes.

‘Tried to stay there mentally’



After the match, Sinner admitted that he had trouble initially while trying to adjust to the "colder" conditions. He said that he tried to keep his composure despite being broken very early in the match.

"I tried to stay there mentally. The conditions were completely different. It's much colder

today. The ball is a bit heavier. I struggled with that a bit. He broke me straight away so that's a straight punch in my face. But I tried to stay there mentally. Trying to understand what might work better," Sinner said in the on-court interview."I stayed there in the first set. Winning 1 game for me was very important for me. Tennis can change quickly. That's what I said yesterday with Casper. Every moment is very crucial. Very happy to be in the final," Sinner added.

With his win, Sinner became the first Italian man to reach the final in Rome since 1978. He also became the youngest man to reach 7 consecutive finals since Ivan Lendl in 1982. Sinner has gone through to the finals in Cincinnati, U.S. Open, Beijing, Shanghai, ATP Finals, Australian Open and Rome.
